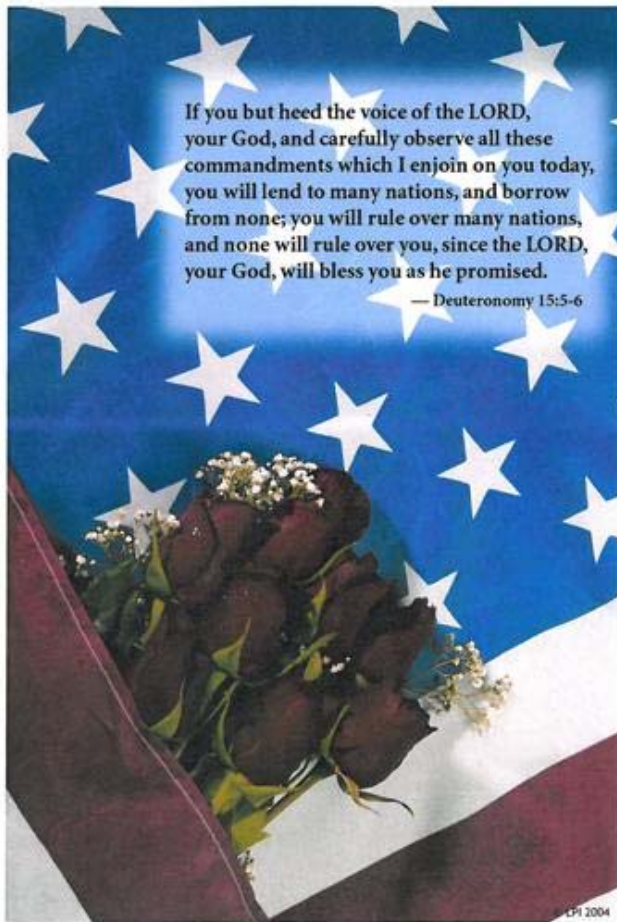

8:42am A single bell will begin to toll from St. Theresa Church and then from The First Congregational Church. The toll will sound for approximately 3600 times for each person killed in NY, DC, PA.

- 9:45am A single bagpipe will sound from St. Theresa front lawn – as a call to gather and remember.
- 10:00am Religious Commemoration Services will be held at St. Theresa Church, First Congregational Church, Unitarian Church and others as well, each according to their own traditions.
- 11:00-11:20am Our townfolk and organizations along with Police, Fire, EMT's and Town Officials will gather on The Common for the 1st Civic call to remember and Taps will be sounded for the 1st time as flag is lowered to half staff.
- 11:40am Lead by Honor Guards, Fire, Police and EMT's – all will gather on the front lawn of St. Theresa Church as we did 10 years ago for our major communal Remembrance ceremony for all victims and nations. Please note: No speeches will be given. Taps will be sounded a 2nd time.
- 12:15pm Final Tribute for all victims and First Responders (Fire, Police, EMT's) who lost their lives and paid the ultimate price. This will be done by our own Police, Fire and EMT's – as taps are sounded for the 3rd and final time.
